- Men's pants 29 to 33 waist only.
- Men's underwear sm and med only
- Shoes for men and women size 8 or smaller only
- Children's shoes not toddler or infant
- Teenage size pants girls and boys
- ALL pants need to be travel worthy. Denim. Dockers...pockets.
- No sweats of any kind.
- No dress pants they need warm clothes.
- Snack foods for travel some salty some sweet
- Belts
- Gloves not bulky
- Lap size travel blankets fleece is best must be lightweight
- Individual tissue packs
- Lip balm
- Small toys hot wheel size for boys and similar for girls.

PLEASE NOTE:

- All travelers are carrying only a reusable size shopping bag or lightweight day back. Their life must fit in there for their few days of travel.
- NOTHING LARGER THAN MEDIUM FOR MEN AND WOMEN.
